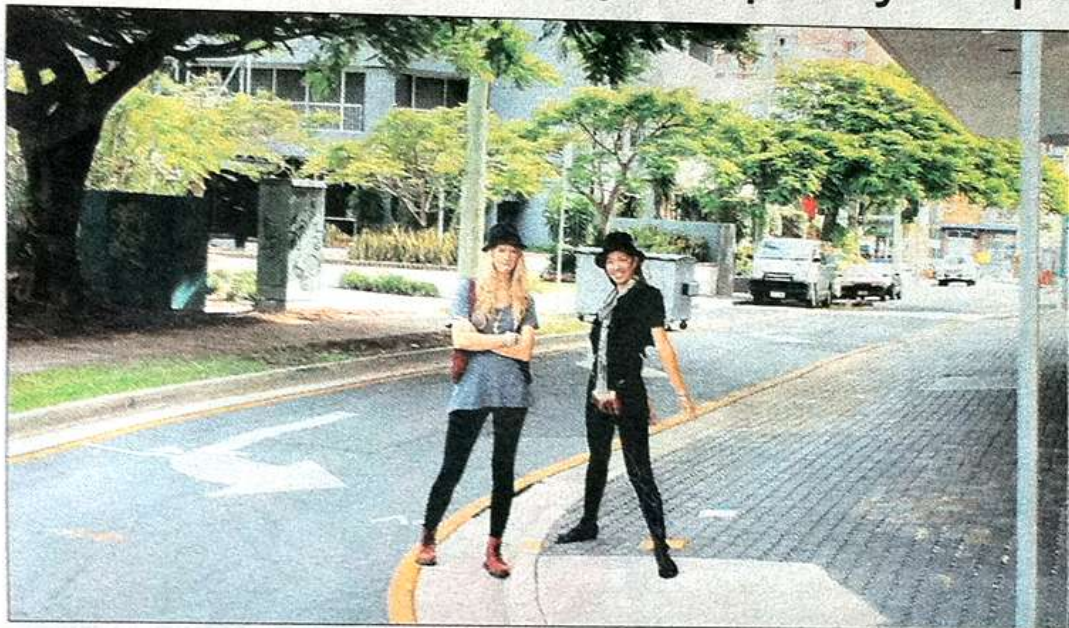


## Art lovers get ready to party in paradise
